GOLD COLLECTION[®] hellebores are vegetatively (vs. from seed) propagated varieties of *Helleborus niger* and hybrids, selected for their upward-facing flowers, compact habit and long bloom period. Most varieties are 9"-18" tall and 9"-24" wide. They all prefer morning sun, good drainage and beautiful cream-colored flowers with accents of green or rose. With all the different varieties, you can have a progression of blooms from November through March!
